1. Square:


- This is a square.
- A square has 4 sides and 4 corners.
- It's all sides are equal.
- Example: Handkerchief, photo frame, Chess-board, Caromboard.

2. Rectangle:

- This is a rectangle.
- A rectangle has 4 sides and 4 corners.
- Its opposite sides are equal.
- Example: carpet, door, windows.

3. Triangle:


- This is a triangle.
- A triangle has 3 sides and 3 corners.
- Example: signboard, sandwich.





4. Circle

- This is a circle.
- A circle has no side no corners.
- Example: Bindi, ring, bangle etc.
