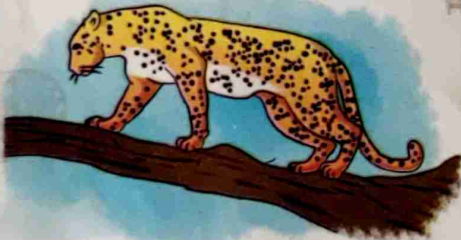

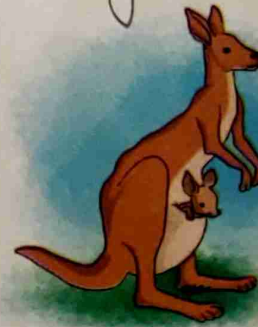

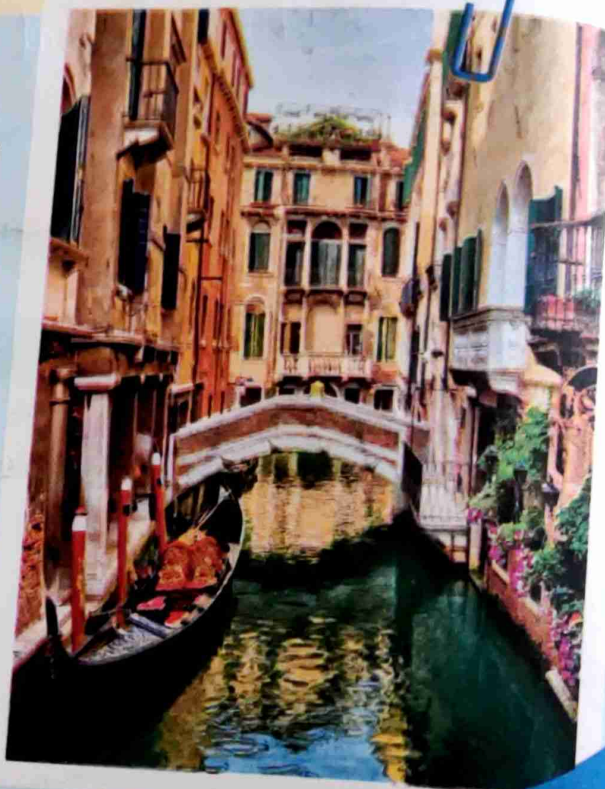
He gave us ice-cream for dessert. We'll complete the trip by Saturday.
