

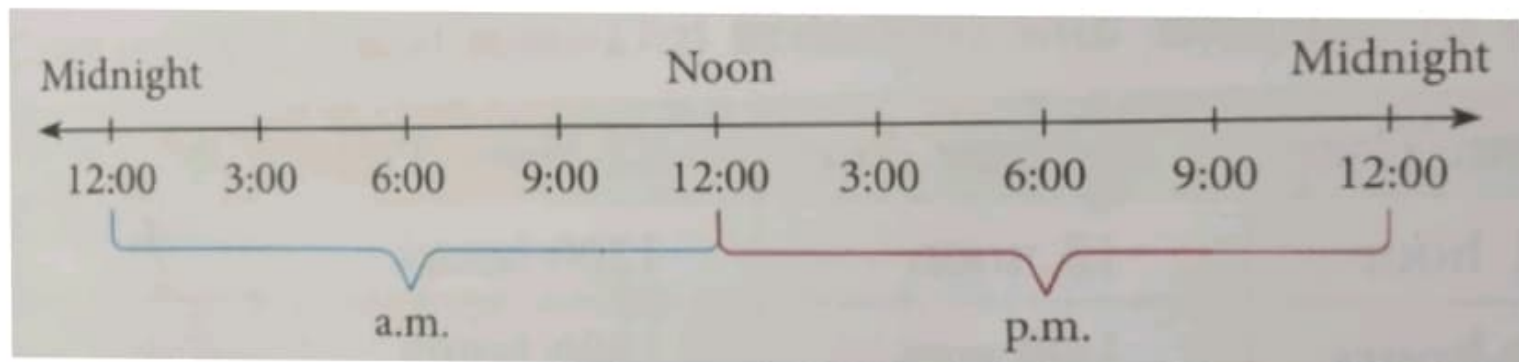
Using a.m and p.m time

Using A.M and P.M Time



- ❖ A day has **24 hours** so in a 12 hour clock the hour hand goes around the clock two times and shows similar time twice a day.
- ❖ To differentiate this, we use *A.M. (ante meridian)* and *P.M. (post meridian)*.
- ❖ **Ante Meridian (a. m)** shows time after Midnight to before noon.
- ❖ **Post Meridian (p. m)** shows time from afternoon to midnight.
- ❖ We do not attach a.m. or p.m. to 12:00. We write 12:00 at midnight as 12 midnight and 12:00 at noon as 12 noon.
- ❖ A day begins at midnight and ends at 12 midnight.
