One major difference between manuscripts and inscriptions is as follows:

Manuscripts: They are handwritten records of the past that were usually written on palm leaves or barks of trees.

Inscriptions: These are writings engraved on hard surfaces like stone or metal.



Ordinary men and women did not generally keep records of what they did as they lead a very simple lifestyle and did not consider it of such importance that it had to be recorded. Moreover, they did not know how to read and write. Only the kings used to maintain records of their victories, people and reign. Such records were maintained by hiring specialised scribes who recorded all important events by writing them down. Kings also employed highly skilled craftsmen who maintained records by inscribing them on stones. Such costly efforts could not be afforded by ordinary people.

Lives of kings would have been different from those of farmers in the following ways:

- (i) Kings were the head and had absolute power over all his subjects. Farmers, on the other hand, led an ordinary life without having any of such powers.
- (ii) Kings lived in palaces while the farmers lived in huts.
- (iii) Kings fought battles to protect his kingdom and people from enemies whereas the farmers produced foods for their kings and other people of the kingdom.
