1. What made Porus a great conqueror?

**Ans**. Porus' courage and self-respect made him a great conqueror. He was confident of his abilities.

  Ans. Alexander sent a message to Porus to surrender his kingdom. This demanding attitude shows that Alexander was a proud and arrogant king.
- 4. How did Porus react to Alexander's message? What kind of a person was he? **Ans**. Porus challenged Alexander to war to defend his kingdom. He was a confident and self-respecting person.
- 5. Why do you think Alexander returned the kingdom to Porus?

**Ans**. Inspite of the defeat, Porus showed immense courage and respect during and after the war. This impressed Alexander, who returned him, his kingdom.
