1. Text-Indent: text indent property specifies the indentation of the first line of a text.

Syntax: text-indent:value

2. Word-Break: word break property specifies the line breaking rules.

Syntax: word-break:value

3. Text-Transform: text transform property is used to transform the letters into uppercase, lowercase or capitalize the first letter of each word.

Syntax: text-transform:value

4. Line-Height: line height property is used to specify the space between two lines of the text.

Syntax: Line-height:value
