Let's Learn

A good vocabulary helps us to use the language with greater effect. A sizable stock of words that constitutes a good vocabulary enables us to use the language efficiently. There are various types of words in English. We classify the vocabulary of a language under different categories, in terms of either their meaning or their appearance.

Categories

Words that sound similar are known as homophones.

Words that are similar in meaning are known as synonyms.

Words that are opposite in meaning are known as antonyms.

Homophones

Homophones are different words that are pronounced in a similar way.



Synonyms and antonyms

Synonyms are words that share the same meaning.



Example: The words royal and regal refer to things related to the king/queen or monarchy. Therefore, the two words are synonymous.

Antonyms are words that are opposite in meaning.



Example: The words common and rare convey opposite meanings.

The word *common* refers to something that is ordinary and easily available while the word *rare* denotes something that is scarce. These are antonyms.
