Isn't it wonderful to be a child?

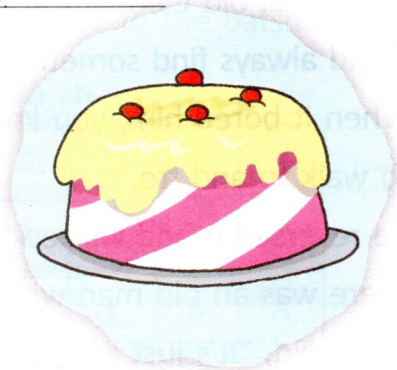

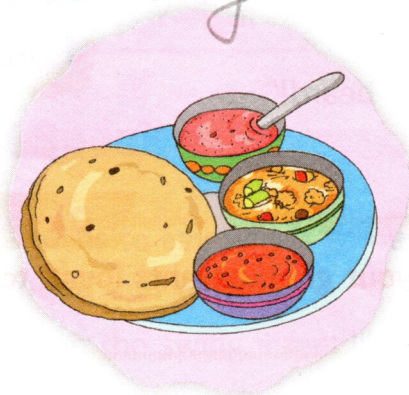
