'Fat', 'cat' and 'hat' are rhyming words.

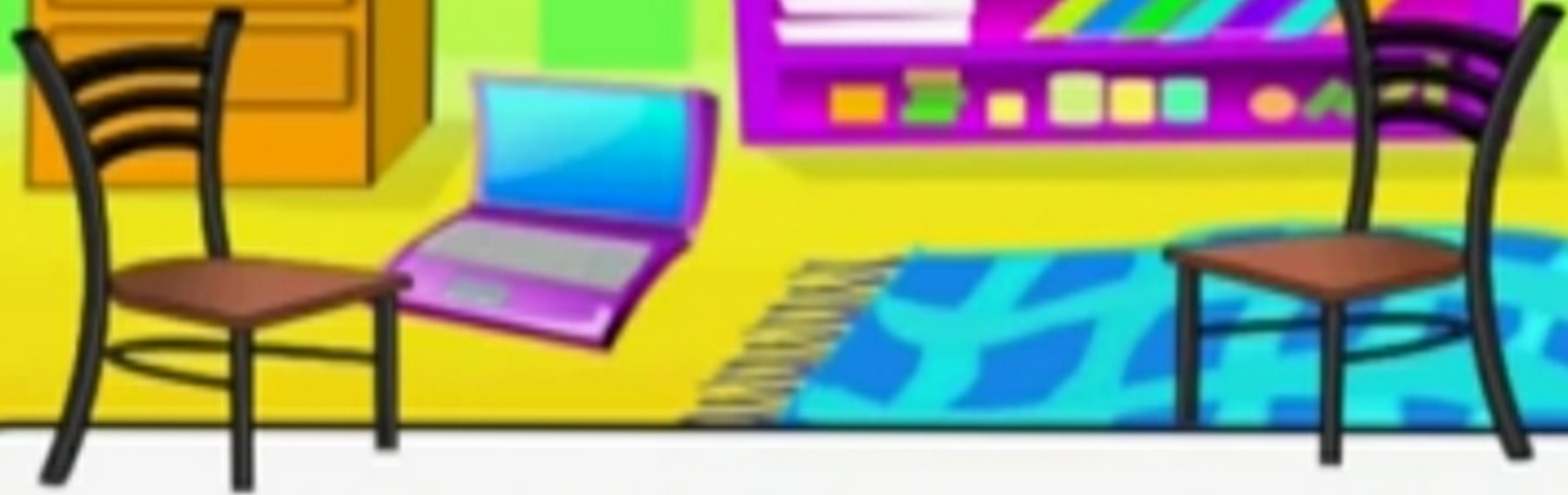




The **cat** is on the **mat**.
