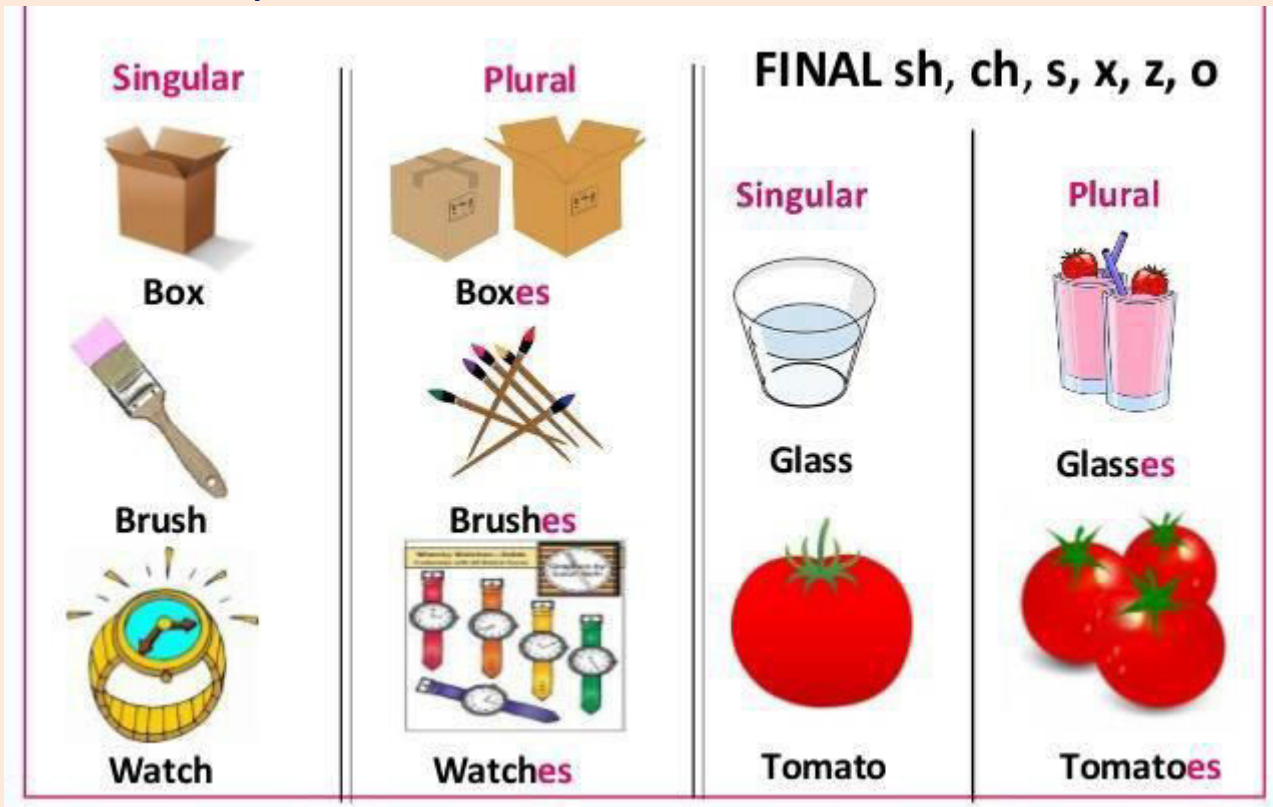


# English Grammar
