Indian place value chart

Take this example; 127896. Can you read this number? No, so in order to read the large numbers easily we split them into groups. Each groups are called periods. Mainly we have 4 types of periods – *Ones period*, *Thousands period*, *Lakhs period* and *Crores period*.

But for now you have to study only till Lakhs period.

Look at the place value chart given below that will help you learn how to read 6-digit and 7-digit numbers.

127896 - One lakh twenty seven thousand eight hundred ninety six.

5412879 – Fifty four lakh twelve thousand eight hundred seventy nine.
